PUBLIC NOTICE: LICENCE RENEWAL PERIOD

To All Licence Holders

In accordance with **Section 64 of the KZN Liquor Licensing Act 2010 (Act. No. 06 of 2010)**, all licence holders are required to submit their licence renewal applications **six months prior to the expiration date of their licences**.

Failure to renew your licence before its expiration date will result in the following consequences:

- **Suspension of Licence:** Your licence will be suspended from the day after the expiration date.
- **Immediate Cessation of Trading:** You will be required to cease all trading activities immediately.
- **Accrual of Penalties:** A penalty will be imposed, equivalent to the renewal fee, for each month that the payment is not received. The penalties will be applied over a three-month period.

If the renewal application and associated penalties are not settled within the fourth month following the expiry date, the licence will expire or lapse.

Please ensure timely renewal to avoid these consequences.
